



## TERMS OF REFERENCE

<b>Session Title</b>	Accelerating towards 2020!	<b>Session Room</b>	BallRoom
<b>Session Length</b>	1h45m		
<b>Background</b>	<p>The Ouagadougou Partnership set an ambitious goal of helping 2.2 million additional women in the region use modern contraception between 2015 and 2020. Thus far, progress has been promising, but additional effort will be necessary for the OP to reach this target.</p> <p>We will help launch the 2017 annual meeting by celebrating past progress towards 2.2 million additional users and considering what interventions contributed the most to such progress, and what types of interventions may be most impactful in years to come. Speakers will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fatimata Sy, the Director of the Ouagadougou Partnership Coordination Unit, to review progress over the past calendar year and to highlight key interventions and challenges along the way. Ms. Sy will focus on region-wide results, but will also include discussion of how different countries performed against their own goals.</li><li>• Emily Sonneveldt, Director of the Ouagadougou Partnership's M&amp;E partner Track20, to look behind the raw "additional user" data to identify how different countries achieved their results (e.g., which interventions and to what effect?). Ms. Sonneveldt will also briefly reflect on what such findings suggest for the future.</li><li>• Exchanges amongst OP countries, on the format of talk show and moderated by Dr Didier Mbayi Kangudie, to allow countries to reflect on their own progress, GAPS and challenges. Most important will be for them to express and share their perspectives and strategies for the future.</li></ul>		
<b>Expected Results</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The Ouagadougou Partnership membership understands how the OP region is doing relative to its 2020 additional user goals, and how each country is doing as well.</li><li>2. Membership identifies specific examples of high-impact and high-visibility interventions, and begins considering whether such efforts could be replicated in their countries.</li><li>3. Membership recognizes the interplay between different kinds of interventions and how, for instance, you may achieve greater results by pairing different kinds of interventions together.</li></ol>
